



Facilities in the tents:

- Comfy beds with super cosy bedding and pillows all ready for your arrival
- Sofabed/Futon (bottom sheet provided)
- Bedside tables and blanket box
- Fridge with small freezer compartment
- Small kettle, mugs, crockery/cutlery box
- Cushions & Blankets, picnic rug
- Fairylights & Bunting
- Lamps/ lighting as well as sockets for charging phones
- Coat stand in Safari tents/hanging rail in Yurts
- Shoe tray to keep outdoor shoes on
- Outdoor patio tables & benches with waterproof cushions
- BBQ with utensils (you will need to provide your own charcoal)

Facilities on site (shared):

- Modern washblock with separate ladies & gents rooms (2 showers, 2 loos, 2 sinks in each, with a few extra essentials in the ladies such as hairdryers & straighteners!)
- Loo roll, hand soap, paper towels, sanitary bags provided
- Covered kitchen area with gas hob burners, microwave, toaster, chopping boards, knives, saucepans, frying pans, cooking utensils, cooking oil, kitchen roll, sink with drainer, washing up liquid, cloths & brushes, large fridge/freezer.
- Separate utility sink area for cleaning BBQs etc
- Sheltered picnic area next to kitchen, some books/games/toys provided
- Plenty of green open space to wander surrounded by farmland, as well as the lakes

Therefore, you will need to bring:

- Food & Drink (there is a well-stocked Costcutter store in the village and we can always recommend a few places to get takeaway or to eat in close by)
- Toiletries & Towels (towels can be hired from us for £5 per person)
- Eyemasks/earplugs are recommended! It's light very early in the Summer months!
- Wellies, warm layers & waterproof jackets (although hopefully you won't need them!)
- Fold up camping chairs for sitting out on the grass if you wish
- Charcoal and firelighters for your BBQ
- Torch for night time loo trips!
